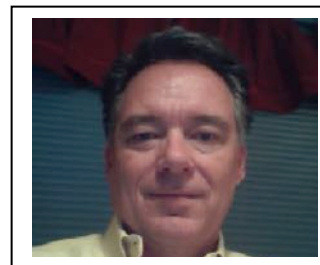

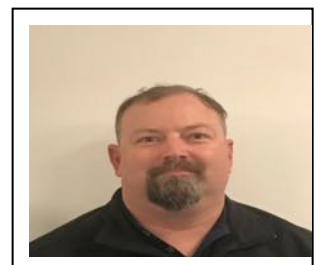
William Etherton
