



Scott is a Fresno native, attending Fresno State and beginning his zoo career at the (then) Roeding Park Zoo. Since then he has worked in a number of zoos around the country, including Reid Park Zoo in Tucson, Woodland Park Zoo (Seattle), Disney’s Animal

Kingdom, Tracy Aviary (Salt Lake City), and as Associate Director, at the Brevard Zoo (Melbourne, FL). He returned to the Fresno Chaffee Zoo in 2009 as the CEO, excited to return home and to use his experience in zoo management, exhibit design, animal care, and guest service in making Fresno Chaffee Zoo one of the best zoos in the country. Scott’s passion for conservation has lead to work on conservation projects in South America, the Caribbean, and Africa. He is honored by having a species named after him, Dennyus bartoni; however it’s a dubious honor since it’s one of the thousands of species of bird louse. Scott has a degree in biology from California State University, Fresno.
